


Communion Class

The class is structured as a series of guided lessons for parents to complete with their children. At Bethlehem, the decision when children participate in Communion is left up to parents and families. This class will be an opportunity for parents and children to learn together about the meaning of the Lord's Supper.

We will learn together about Communion, and then dismiss for worship where we will be sharing Communion during the service.
